WELCOME TO PRINCETON NJ., ENJOY AN HISTORIC TOUR OF DRUMTHWACKET MANSION AND TEA AT THE PEACOCK INN.

This Greek Revival mansion was built circa 1834 for Charles S. Olden, Governor of New Jersey during the Civil War. Moses Taylor Pyne, the second owner, enlarged the house in the late 1890's. Now owned by the State of New Jersey, it is the official residence of the Governor.

The original Peacock Inn dates back to the 1700s, and the property became an interesting part of the area's history. It is believed that the basement area of The Peacock Inn, also known as "Peacock Alley", was used as a Prohibition-era speakeasy. The Inn is pleased to bring Afternoon Tea to Princeton, which includes 3 elegant tiers of savories and sweets, with loose leaf tea.
